Please read this Privacy Policy ("Policy") carefully before using the Voice-ping.com website and app (the "Service") operated by p2p Corporation ("p2p", "us", "we", or "our").

This page is used to inform website visitors regarding our policies with the collection, use, and disclosure of Personal Information for anyone using to use our Service.

If you choose to use our Service, then you agree to the collection and use of information in relation with this policy. The Personal Information that we collect is used for providing and improving the Service. We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

The terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms and Conditions, unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy

Information collection

Information we may collect about you includes:

Correspondence Information: For a better experience while using our Service, we may require you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information, including but not limited to your name and email address. The information that we collect will be used to contact you with updates to our service. You can change your email address or unsubscribe to these emails at any time.

Support Information: You may provide information to us via a support request submitted through the Services. We will use this information to assist you with your support request. Please do not submit any information to us via a support submission, including confidential or sensitive information that you do not wish for our Service Providers to have access to or use in the future.

Information collected by and from social media services and other third-party platforms: Certain aspects of the Services allow you to link or integrate third-party products and services to enable certain features and functionalities with the Services. For example, you can connect your Google Calendar account to sync up status with Voice Ping. If you choose to use these features or functionalities, you may be asked to create an account with a third-party service provider or link your existing account with that service provider (and, by doing so, agree to the privacy policy and/or terms and conditions of that third-party). You may also be asked to authorize Voice Ping to collect information from the third-party service provider on your behalf. We will then collect information from you and/or that third-party service provider as necessary to enable the Services to access your data and content stored with that third-party service provider. Once the authentication is complete, we have the ability to access information you provided to us or was otherwise collected by the third-party service in accordance with the privacy practices of that third-party service. We will store the information and data we collect and associate it with your Voice Ping account, and we will use that information and data to enable the integration of the Services with the third-party service provider and to perform actions requested or initiated by you, or that are reasonably necessary to carry out instructions provided by you.

Information we collect automatically through your use of the Services includes:

Log file information: Whenever you visit our Service, we collect information that your browser sends to us that is called Log Data. This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser version, pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and other statistics. When you access the Service using a mobile device, we may collect additional device information, such as the type of device you are using, its operating system, and mobile network information.

Information collected by our desktop applications (Mac, Windows and Linux): We may also collect applications currently being worked on, web URLs visited, time you are active, the names of projects or tasks being worked on, the amount of time worked on those tasks, the browser version you are using.

Cookies

Cookies are files with small amount of data that is commonly used an anonymous unique identifier. These are sent to your browser from the website that you visit and are stored on your computer's hard drive.

Our website may use these "cookies" to keep you signed in to our Service. You have the option to either accept or refuse these cookies by changing your browser settings. If you choose to refuse our cookies, you will not stay signed in once you close your browser tab or window.

Where we store your data

p2p transfers, processes and stores data about you on servers operated by our hosting provider located in the United States of America. Your Personal Information may therefore be transferred to, processed and stored in a country different from your country of residence, and be subject to privacy laws that are different from those in your country of residence. Information collected within the European Economic Area ("EEA") and Switzerland may, for example, be transferred to and processed by third parties referred to below that are located in a country outside of the EEA and Switzerland, where you may have fewer rights in relation to your Personal Information. By using the Service and providing us with your Personal Information, you are consenting to the transfer, processing and storage of your Personal Information in countries outside of your country of residence.

Security

We value your trust in providing us your Personal Information, thus we strive to use all commercially acceptable means of protecting it. However, no method of transmission over the internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure and reliable, and we cannot guarantee its absolute security.
